## DIOCESAN NOVENA TO THE SACRED HEART

May 30th to June 7th, the Feast of the Sacred Heart. As Bishop Alan McGuckian begins his time as bishop of the diocese he would love everyone in the diocese to join him in nine days of prayer asking Jesus to give us a new heart.
