# BENEDICTION OF THE MOST BLESSED SACRAMENT

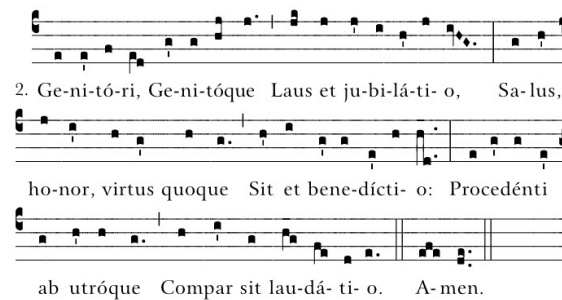
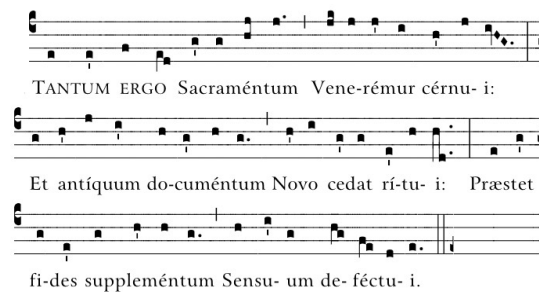
*When the Most Blessed Sacrament is exposed the hymn of praise is sung*
