Benediction of the Most Blessed Sacrament—Why does the priest put a veil over his hands to give the benediction? When a priest gives a blessing he usually makes the sign of the cross over a person or object. When the priest imparts benediction from the monstrance however, it is lesus who gives the blessing and not the priest. The priest puts on the humeral veil over his shoulders and covering his hands when taking up the monstrance to demonstrate that the blessing does not come from his own hands but from Jesus, who is really and truly present in the Eucharist.

Communion fast—what is the practice of the Catholic church with regard to fasting before Holy Communion? The Church invites the faithful to fast for one hour before receiving Holy Communion. This means that for the hour before we receive Jesus at mass we abstain from any food and drink with the exception of water and medicine. This ancient practice disposes the soul to yearn for Jesus who is the Bread of Life and to prepare our bodies to welcome him into our lives.
