With grateful thanks to God for a very blessed and peaceful six months I take my leave of the Parish of Newtownards and Comber. I can truly say that the tremendous sense of welcome and generosity that I have received here has been the fruit of prayer. In the months before I arrived in the parish, whilst still in the Holy Land, I was praying very decidedly that all would go well and that I could serve the parish happily.

Returning to the place of my birth, and to get to know the place and the people in a new way brought me a particular joy. The celebration of my tenth anni-

versary of priestly ordination at the start of May was an equally memorable moment that brought me renewed enthusiasm to the promises I made on the day of Ordination.
