CARE OF THE SICK IN HOSPITAL Each Hospital has an appointed Chaplin, whose Ministry to the sick includes visiting patients in the hospital, administering the Sacrament of the sick, celebrating the Sacrament of confession, and attending emergences within the hospital, Fr Henry Mc Cann and Sister Ann are the appointed Chaplin's at the Ulster hospital. Fr Conor Mc Grath and Fr Brian Mc Cann also provide cover for emergency sick calls at certain times each week. When requiring a Priest to visit sick at the hospital staff can call for the Priest through the SWITCHBOARD ONLY. The staff will contact the Priest that is on duty.

BLESSED CARLO ACUTIS This weekend ,September 7th, Pope Leo XIV will canonize Blessed Carlo Acutis in St Peters square in Rome. Blessed Carlo lived a very short life, born on the 3rd of May 1991 in London died on 12th October 2006 in London at the age of 15. In his teenage years, he was a gamer and computer coder who loved the Eucharist. He was diagnosed with leukemia as a teenager. In 2006 he offered his sufferings to the Lord for the Pope and for the Church in order not to go to Purgatory but to go straight to Heaven. Of the Mass he wrote The more Eucharist we receive, the more we become like Jesus and the more we get a foretaste of Heaven. Here in St Patrick's Church we have an etching of Carlo Acutis in the recently restored side Chapel. Blessed Carlo, or Saint Carlo as he will be known The Patron Saint of young people. We pray that they may be encouraged by the example of Saint Carlo and be helped by his prayers. Saint Carlo, pray for us today.
