### FEAST OF THE EXALTATION OF THE HOLY CROSS

This weekend we celebrate the Feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross (September 14th) As it is a major feast, it replaces the Sunday in Ordinary Time. This feast celebrates the victory of our Saviour, Jesus Christ upon the Cross. the feast has its origins in the discovery of the True Cross by Saint Helena in the year 326. Helena embarked on a pilgrimage to the Holy Land. Her mission was to identify significant sites from Christ's life and establish churches at these locations. In Jerusalem she aimed to find the True Cross and to build a church over the sites of Mount Calvary and Jesus' tomb, known as the Holy Sepulchre. Upon identifying Mount Calvary and the empty tomb, she discovered three discarded and buried crosses. After an investigation, the local bishop confirmed they were the crosses used to crucify Jesus and the two thieves. Saint Helena did not know which cross as Christ's, so she arranged for a sick woman to touch all three. The woman was immediately healed upon touching one of them, indicating that it was the True Cross. On this Feast Day, we give thanks for Christ's victory over sin and death. With the whole church we proclaim:

"We adore you and we praise you O Christ; because by Your Holy Cross, You have redeemed the world."

# CARE OF THE SICK IN HOSPITAL

Each hospital has an appointed Chaplain, whose Ministry to the sick includes visiting patients in the hospital, administering the Sacrament of the Sick celebrating the Sacrament of Confession, and attending emergences within the hospital. Fr Henry McCann and Sister Ann are the appointed chaplains at the Ulster hospital. Fr Conor Mc Grath and Fr Brian McCann also provide cover for emergency sick calls at certain times each week. When requiring a priest to visit a sick family member in hospital, the staff in the ward will contact the SWITCHBOARD of the hospital, who will in turn contact the priest who is on duty.
