PREPARING FOR THE MONTH OF OCTOBER

This Wednesday signals to first day of October, There are two emphases during October. The month is always dedicated to Our Lady of the Rosary, and it is also a special time of prayer for the Church on the mission fields. We are encouraged to pray the Rosary each day, individually or collectively. within our families, parishes, online platforms, EWTN, and some parishioners even pray the Rosary with friends on whatsapp calls!

As we pray the Rosary, we focus on the mysteries of Christ's life;: the joyful times, the experiences of his sorrows, the manifestations of his light, and indeed the experience of his glories. The rhythm of each Hail Mary enables us to pray with the heart.

During various apparitions of Our Lady in various parts of the world, which have gained the clear approval of the church, Our Blessed Mother has promised many graces resulting from the praying the daily Rosary. In fact, the Rosary kept the flame of faith alive in the church, particularly during times of persecution when Catholics were not allowed to attend Mass. Our faith too will remain alive with the help of Our Lady.

Each Hail Mary contains words taken from the scriptures 'Hail Mary, Full of grace, the Lord is with thee.'.....the words of greeting used by the Archangel Gabriel during the annunciation. Every time we pray the Hail Mary, we ask our Blessed Mother, to pray for us sinners, now, and at the hour of our death. Let us unite our prayers with hers during the month of October.
